Dear Doctor:


Ed and I have corresponded and talked further about his coming here to establish his office. I feel very strongly that we need someone like him in Austin, particularly since I think that some of the segregation bills are going to pass.

I think it so important that Ed settle here that I am now trying to raise a retainer fee for him for the next two years from one of the foundations. We need a general counsel on civil liberties and political action with headquarters here. While I am not sure that I will get the grant of money, I am going to keep trying for it.

Also, as I told you over the phone some time ago, I am prepared to make Ed an interest-free loan of \$1,000. However, he will need a loan totaling \$2,000. and I do not have that much. I earnestly hope that you can help him out with \$1,000. If you can, let us write him our checks simultaneously so that he will receive the \$2,000. all at once and thus be certain of the money and, therefore, justified in making a definite commitment to move. Once he is settled here I think that he will be able to develop a good practice.
