 3. Feb. 8 thru Feb. Feb. 14 (4 PM). Stayed at Port of Spain, Trinidad.
 4. Feb 14, Left Pt of Spain Trinidad via Pan Am. arrived N.Y. City. Left NY. City at night 9 P.M. Arrived Washington, D.C. about 11 P.M.
