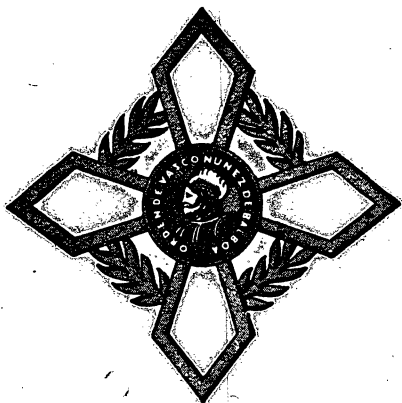

On the recommendation of the President of the Republic of Panama, the National Assembly on the 28th of January, 1933, passed Legislation creating the National Decoration of the Order of Vasco Nunez de Balboa in honor of the Great Discoverer of the Pacific Ocean, said Order to be conferred upon Citizens of the Republic of Panama who may have performed outstanding services to the Country or in the field of Arts and Sciences may have distinguished themselves through works of recognized worth or constructive benefit to the Nation and for general progress, and to Citizens of other nations whom the Chief Executive may consider worthy of the Decoration and distinction. The Decoration is conferred by the President of the Republic of Panama who has the Rank of "Gran Maestre" of the Order and through the intercession of the Board of Trustees of said Order. The various decorations are of the following ranks: "Gran Cruz", which is the highest rank, "Oficial", "Comendador", and "Caballero" which are conferred according to merits and work of the person whom the government wishes to honor with the Decoration.
