National Commission Meeting to be held in Washington, D. C.

The Executive Committee set the above dates for the 34th Annual Meeting of the National Commission to be held at the Statler Hilton Hotel in Washington, D. C.

Principal topics for the meeting will be International Education Year, responsibilities of the Commission regarding problems of "Man and His Environment", 16th General Conference issues and long-term programs, election of officers, and rotation of organizations represented on the Commission. Pursuant to the recommendation of the Membership Committee, all members are urged to submit, by May 15, nominations for organizations that they feel should be considered for representation on the Commission.

Appropriate background papers and an agenda will be sent to you at a later date. At the moment, our plans call for the meeting to start September 17, Thursday afternoon, or evening with a reception, dinner and major address. It would continue on Friday and terminate Saturday noon, September 19th.
