
Dear Dr. Garcia:

Your address was given to me by Mrs. Margie Jenkins in Jenison, Mich. She told me that your sister is working on your family genealogy. As it is possible that there is some connection between your family and mine I would like to tell you very briefly about some of my family tree and ask that you pass this on to your sister. If she thinks that there might be a connection we could further pursue the subject.

My family history is connected to the Flores Grant in what is now Duval County, Texas. Very early names in the tree are Diego de Villarreal and Don Bernabe de las Casas. Also, Diego Hinojosa. Many relatives lived in Monterrey. I have Garcias on both sides, going back to Colonel Remigio Garcia, born about 1790, and married on 26 July 1811 in Mier, near Larado, to a Flores.

I would be happy to exchange family tree charts if you think that it would be worthwhile.
