On Saturday evening, December 1, 1973, we are planning a statewide appreciation dinner honoring Sissy Farenthold.

1973 has been a busy and rewarding year for Sissy. She was elected Chairwoman of the Texas Health Security Action Committee, and immediately following, she was elected Chairwoman of the National Women's Political Caucus. Sissy campaigned for the Equal Rights Amendment in twelve states; was commencement speaker at Vassar College, the University of Pennsylvania at Harrisburg, the University of Texas School of Nursing, to mention only three out of a score; was main speaker at the National Convention Banquet of Americans for Democratic Action; received honorary degrees from Hood College and Boston University; testified before three congressional committees; spent two weeks in the Soviet Union as a guest of the Soviet Women's Committee; and, incidentally, in between everything else, delivered 35 university lectures in 21 states.
