
This letter is to once again express my appreciation for your continued interest in our Election Code revision process. I would also like to bring you up to date on our latest progress.

We have now completed our discussion, except for a final discussion and vote, on all the titles of the proposed code except Title 110C--Regulating Political Funds and Campaigns. Our final meeting of the year will be a one-day meeting at 10 a.m. on Tuesday, December 18, 1984, in the senate chamber. Please disregard the December 19 date indicated in the previous letter. At this meeting we will be voting on Titles 13--Recounts, 14--Election Contests, and 11--Presidential Elections. We will also be using this meeting to discuss and vote on issues in the previously adopted titles that members would like to have reconsidered. I am hopeful that we will be able to completely finish our discussion and voting on all the titles except Title 110C at the December 18 meeting.

The subcommittee I appointed on Title 110C will report to the Study and Advisory Committees at a meeting to be scheduled in early January, 1985. I will be back in touch with you to inform you of a specific date for the January meeting.

Please let me know if I can provide you with additional information. I look forward to seeing you on December 18.
