THE FRIDAY MORNING GROUP

The Friday Morning Group is an unusual organization. In fact, it is not an organization; it has no officers, no bylaws and no projects, simply a moderator and a program committee.

Composed of businessmen who are vitally interested in the affairs of our community, it has become one of the important groups of Corpus Christi. Most members actively participate in some form of civic service.

The meetings are held each Friday morning at the Corpus Christi Yacht Club. Coffee and doughnuts are served at 7:30 a.m. The meetings are informal with members free to move around, refill coffee cups, etc.

Speakers are introduced by the moderator at 7:40 and expected to speak for 20 to 30 minutes, at which time the floor is opened for questions from members. The question and answer period is of extreme value and importance in that it gives the Group an opportunity to delve into areas of interest.
