General Spiller's letter addressed to you and our letter dated 10 May 1974.

We are taking this opportunity to register another of our "unfounded allegations", as General Spiller has stated. Mr. Jesse Torres, MAWFSC, filed an EFD complaint with the DEO counselor, Mr. Oren Mulkey, Directorate of Maintenance. After Mr. Mulkey compiled his findings and prepared a written report regarding the circumstances, he furnished copies to Mr. Torres and his Union Representative, Mr. William C. Johnson, He was chastised by his superiors for his favor of compassion and justification to Mr. Torres' EEO complaint. He was ordered to obtain said copies from Mr. Torres and his Union Representative and to tone down the original findings in order to show that a condition of non-compliance with NEO directives was non-existent. This additional allegation is still part of our original complaint of preferential treatment.

We still charge that a situation of pre-selection, and ambiguous qualification has been used against Mr. Torres in his non-selection for promotion and that there is a justifiable complaint of discrimination.
