Dear Dr. Hector P. Garcia,

Attached is a narrative of a proposal submitted to the Community Services Administration by the Nueces County Community Action Agency under the terms of the Job Opportunities Program, Title X of the Public Works and Economic Development Act of 1965. The purpose of the grant would be to: (1) expand our weatherization program into the rural areas of Nueces County and (2) to subcontract with the Texas Agricultural Extension Service for home education services in thr rural areas on energy conservation, nutrition, hygeine, etc. The proposal is for \$318,000.

In soliciting your support of the proposal, we are reminded of your long-time advocacy of the poor and all prgrams that provide direct benefits to the poor. Title X Weatherization and Home Services is much a project. The worthiness of the project is emphasized by the fact that of over one thousand proposals submitted to CSA, the one submitted by NCCAA was one of the fifteen selected for review by the Department of Commerce.

We, therefore, respectfully request letters of support from you to Mr. Rogers Morton, Secretary of Commerce and to our Congressional representatives.
