## GENERAL INFORMATION

You are cordially invited to attend a Fourth of July celebration aboard the Naval Air Station, commencing at 7:00 p.m. on Sunday, 4 July 1976. The celebration is being co-sponsored by the Corpus Christi Buccaneer Commission, Corpus Christi Army Depot, and Corpus Christi Naval Air Station to commemorate this Nation's 200th anniversary. This event is listed on the official bicentennial calendar and represents a unique opportunity for each of us to participate and enjoy our anniversary.

The celebration will include a parade of marching units, bands and military units, which are representative of the local area. After the parade, there will be a 21-gun salute, lowering of colors, capped by an extensive fireworks display. Refreshments and light snacks will be available at minimum cost along the seawall area.

As a special guest to this celebration, you will be accorded special parking and seating arrangements during the festivities. Please note the enclosure to this invitation. The first item is a VIP pass, which should be prominently displayed in the lower left portion of the windshield. This pass will allow the traffic directors to route your vehicle to the designated parking area. To further guide you to the parking and seating areas, a map is printed on the reverse side of the parking pass.

The Naval Air Station Officers' Club will be open after the fireworks. A special route has been designated to facilitate driving to the Officers' Club. (Please note enclosed map.) Since this will be the only major fireworks display in the area, we are expecting about 70,000 people aboard and on the accesses to the Naval Air Station. We hope our special guests avoid the traffic congestion after the fireworks and enjoy the music of the Chief of Naval Air Training Rand at the Officers' Club.
