Dear Dr. Garcia,

The Nueces County Community Action Agency is a private, non-profit corporation that operates programs designed to alleviate conditions that cause poverty. These programs include Head Start, Neighborhood Service Centers, Minor Home Repairs and Weatherization and Crisis Intervention (food and utility bills). Within these programs, NCCAA offers a variety of services that focus on serving the family unit and instituting social changes that will have positive effects on the lives of the poor.

Working towards this end is a Board of Directors comprised of forty-two members. Seventeen members are representatives of the poor, elected by their respective councils. Public officials (city, county, state and local school boards) and/or their representatives are allocated fourteen seats on the board. Organizations that represent civic, labor, industry, business, welfare, civil rights, religion, and other groups hold eleven seats. Each year, the representatives of the poor and the public officials and members of the corporation select the organizations that will serve on the board. This is done at the annual meeting, which will be held December 13th, this year.
