Army regulations state that when a service member is absent without authority for ten (10) consecutive days, he is charged as absent without leave and a letter to next of kin is sent to his nearest relative.

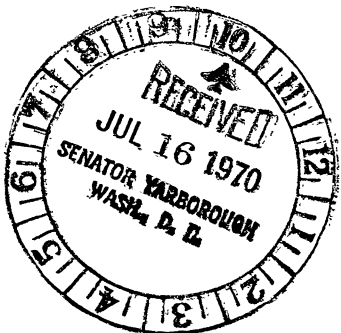
