Dear Congressman:

This will refer to our letter of March 24, 1967, and other correspondence, concerning the postmaster vacancy at Woodboro, Texas. On March 16, 1966, the Civil Service Commission issued a certificate of eligibles containing the following names:

James R. Johnston (5-pt. vet. pref.)
William H. Kennedy (5-pt. vet. pref.)
Harry Cummins, Jr. (5-pt. vet. pref.)

The Commission has given the Department until May 20, 1967 in which to make a selection. In the absence of your recommendation by that date, we will select Mr. James R. Johnston, the No. 1 eligible, and so notify the Commission.

We regret having to proceed without your concurrence, but we have no alternative.
