I have again been contacted by Captain Bourgoise of the Marine Casualty list with further regard to the condition of your son, PFC Vernon A. Lucich.

The report which we have now received from the U. S. Naval Hospital in Yokosuka, Japan, indicates that your son's diagnosis was a seizure disorder of unknown etiology. His condition is very good and his prognosis is likewise very good. The Navy announced that he will return to 6 months of limited duty in approximately 10 days.

I was glad to find this information for you and I am happy that your son is doing well. If in the future you have further need of my services, please do not hesitate to contact me.


I want to acknowledge your letter of April 25 written in behalf of the request of Private First Class Amado G. Garza for a hardship discharge.




Dear Dr. Hector:
