Dear Senator Yarborough:

This is in reply to your letter of July 18, 1963, and related correspondence concerning Mr. Joe G. Chavez.

A review of our records indicates that Mr. Chavez is an honorably discharged veteran of World War II with no service connected disabilities. On January 7, 1963, we received an application for hospitalization from him by mail. Our admitting physician reviewed the application and from the medical statement contained therein, classified it as a routine medical application and placed it on the waiting list pending the availability of a bed.

On June 17, 1963, an authorization was mailed to Mr. Chavez authorizing him to report June 21, 1963. This authorization was returned unclaimed. We have since learned that Mr. Chavez is now residing at 2625 Soledad, Corpus Christi, Texas.

We are happy to advise that we now have Mr. Chavez rescheduled to report July 29, 1963. A notice to this effect has been mailed to the veteran.
