Dear Garcia,

The information you requested concerning our conversation last night is as follows:

The several position vacancies we talk about were in the area as stated below, however, I would accept any position, if given the opportunity to work with the Office of Equal Employment Commission.

1. The position I am requesting is that of Ass't Equal Employment Officer of the Post Office Department, Washington, D.C.

2. Second, the position of Equal Employment Officer with the Education Division of the Department of Health, Education and Welfare. The Health and Welfare will eventually work under one Chairman and that would leave the Department of Education as one sole Department with a Cabinet post. Millions of Dollars are being spent in this Department that it is almost an impossibility for this Department to be constructive under one Chairman.

3. Third, and one I would prefer to work in (with my good friend Jimenez) is with the Equal Employment Commission. I believe the Commission is in vital need of Officers or Representative who know the problems confronting the Mexican-American and who will enforce the laws and regulation as set forth the Commission. As it is now, there is not enough aggressiveness because of the inexperience of the personnel and because the person holding the vital high position are not of the Minority Group or Mexican-American with Mexican Surnames. To set action on the above is to have someone with the authority to enforce the policies as set forth in the Executive Orders or Regulation of the Commission. I can be that person, and I can say I am qualified in every respect. I can also say I certainly do a better job as that of our counterpart.

Dr. Garcia, you are a symbol and certainly you of all persons would want Equal Employment, Promotion, and betterment for the Mexican-American to materialize. The opportunity is there and now, we may never get this chance again. I promise I will never let you down or bring discredit to your goals.
