Dear Arnold:

Thank you for your letter of November 29 furnishing the letter from Dr. Garcia and the application of Mr. Muguerza.

I realize that you suggested that I look into opportunities for Mr. Muguerza and advise Dr. Garcia direct; however, since I have not been able to work out anything here in the Region and do not anticipate being able to work out anything in the foreseeable future, I believe it best to return the application to you in the event you are in a position to try to place Mr. Muguerza in the Department or in the Internal Audit Branch of the Inspection Service.

I have discussed employment opportunities for Mr. Muguerza with our Regional Controller and our Regional Director. As the situation now stands we have just recently completed absorption of the Denver Accounting function and the Accounting personnel of that Region. This has left us with surplus people and no opportunity at all for placement of Mr. Muguerza. Also, when the current program for fully utilizing the new 1401 data processing machine is completed, we anticipate additional surplus Accounting personnel.

As you can see, circumstances simply do not provide for any favorable consideration of Mr. Muguerza's application.

We realize that he has excellent qualifications and for this reason we are returning his application to you with the hope that you may be able to work out something for him at the departmental level.

I hope that you can work out something for Mr. Muguerza because as you know, I have the greatest of respect for Dr. Garcia and his recommendation.
