Dr. Garcia in one of my attached papers I exaggerate a little of my organization years work with the Forum. But this is because of some ruling by the Civil Service Commission requirements for Investigator's work. This also was told to me by one of the Investigators himself as a requirement. He had to do a little exaggeration himself to get the position. He has never been question about it. Perhaps because he said he was far more qualified in experience and education as his other fellow investigators.

I have sent Chairman Macy two letters and one Form 57 complete, and to date I have received only negative answers by no encouragement as to job opportunities or promotion. Yet I see and talk to persons employed by the commission with less experience and education get the juicy positions and give the Mexican American the left-overs.

I believed the Various Governmental Agencies are still trying to keep us (Better Educated) on the bottom and with no chance to get ahead because the high level position and training for those position are still been given to them (High Management). And subsequently, when we applied for these position, we are not qualified.

This is frustrated for the Mexican-American people who can now qualify for any position if given the chance to learn the job is only nullified by the mere words (Not Qualified).

I, myself, as you know me better than anyone else, have fulfilled the requirements of the position given and with good recommendation from my superiors or organization chairmans

I know I will not let you down in any position given me and a chance to do good to my country as well as my people. This, I can truthfully promise.
