Dear Rudy:

Only a short note to send you a copy of the letter I have written Mr. Friesen from the U. S. Attorney's General's office in reply to a letter I received from him today. I am going to withhold sending out the letter to him and these who appear at the bettom of the letter until next Sunday. I am sending you a copy first so that you might check it to see that it does not compromise either you personally or the G I Forum. You might also want to check it with Louis Martin. At any rate, I must have your comments by return Air Mail because I intend to mail the letter out next Sunday, December 5. If I am to get your comments in time you must air mail your letter to me not later than Exiday Thursday or Friday morning, Dec. 2 or 3. I would very much like to get your comments before I send it out, but if I do not hear from you by next week I'll send it out anyway.
