

Dear Mr. Young:

This is in reference to the letter of 19 August 1968, this headquarters, in the interest of Private E-1 Cornelio Lugo, US 54 720 032, a member of Headquarters and Headquarters Battery, 2d Battalion, 21st Artillery, Schofield Barracks, Hawaii, APO San Francisco 96557.

Private Lugo's suspended sentence to confinement at hard labor for four months has been revoked due to his involvement in a fight on 16 August 1968. He has been confined in the post stockade at this station since the evening of 19 August 1968. Circumstances surrounding this case are still under investigation.

You will be advised further in this matter.
