Dr. Logan died for a cause. He apposed the treatment given the Mexican Americans for 150 years. He had the raw courage to fight back, to support the underedog, to openly state that malnutrition, poverty, and inhumane treatment existed, and for this "The Establishment" killed him. Yet I see in the Saturday Caller Times, that the Mexican American delegates supported Bentsen for Senator and I suppose they will support Smith for Governor. If they do it will be a direct insult to my son and his death will be a hollow mockery.

In 150 years, the Democratic Party has offered the Mexican Americans nothing but degradation, poverty, insults, and police brutality.
