DEAR GOVERNOR DOCKING:

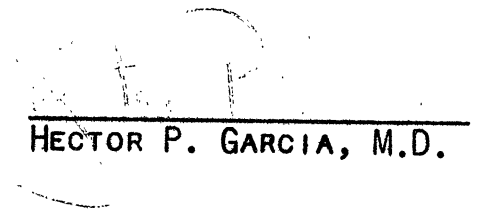
THANK YOU VERY MUCH FOR YOUR KIND LETTER OF FEBRUARY 13. I
