My dear Senator:

In response to your letters of March 6 and 7, 1956, which enclosed information received from Dr. Hector P. Garcia, I wish to advise that a preliminary investigation is being conducted by our Miami, Florida, Office in order that a determination may be made as to whether a possible violation of Federal law is involved in this matter. The results of this Bureau's investigation will be furnished to the Criminal Division of the Department of Justice for its consideration and its determination as to whether further action will be taken. Mr. Warren Olney III, Assistant Attorney General in charge of the Criminal Division of the Department of Justice, is being advised of your interest in this matter. If further information is desired, it is suggested that you may wish to correspond with Mr. Olney.
