Did you know that diabetes is one of the leading causes of death by disease in the United States? Of the nearly 11 million Americans who have diabetes, about 40% **DO NOT KNOW** they have it. And... about 300,000 of all Texans with diabetes are Mexican Americans. Mexican Americans suffer from diabetes at a 300% higher rate and Blacks a 33% higher rate, than does the rest of America.
