**MOTION:**

I move that the Election Committee certify and adopt Exhibit "A", entitled ELECTION OF MEMBERS TO THE GROUP INSURANCE ADVISORY COMMITTEE - FINAL RESULTS, as the final results of the Group Insurance Advisory Committee election and certify to the Board of Trustees that Dave Kinnaman, D. Wanda Garcia, and Patricia M. Kuhles are the three eligible candidates receiving the highest number of votes and are elected to serve a three year term beginning September 1, 1990 and continuing through August 31, 1993. A total of 3,967 votes, representing 17% of the eligible voters, were cast. Approximately 23,250 ballots were distributed to agencies whose employees were eligible to vote.
