Dear Dr. Garcia:

I have seen Cecilia back in follow-up and she is doing significantly better than when she was in the hospital. She has had marked improvement of her left leg and her right leg is moderately improved. Her trunk is at least 50% better and her hands are significantly better. Currently she is on Prednisone 20 mg daily and this will be decreased to 20 mg on alternate days in a few days. We have decided to treat her with alternate day therapy in a low dose for one month to see if we can stabilize her condition.

It was certainly a pleasure to meet you and your wife while you were here visiting. Hopefully I can visit with you again when I come to Corpus Christi.

The circular on the cover, reproduced from the Dr. Hector P. Garcia Papers, is a seminal document in the struggle for Mexican American civil rights. It announced the protest meeting in 1949 organized by Dr. Garcia and the American G.I. Forum, when the funeral home director in Three Rivers, Texas, refused to allow the use of his chapel for the reburial of Pvt. Felix Longoria, an American soldier who had died in combat in World War II.

#### Dr. Hector P. Garcia

Physician, civic activist, and longtime Corpus Christi resident, Dr. Hector P. Garcia, has been a spokesman for the Mexican American community for over forty years. Born in 1914 in Llera, Tamaulipas, he moved with his family in 1917 to Mercedes, Texas. He received his B.A. from the University of Texas in 1936, graduated from the University of Texas School of Medicine in 1940, and interned in Omaha, Nebraska. During his distinguished military service in World War II, he met and married Wanda Fusillo. They had four children, Daisy Wanda, Hector, Adriana Cecilia, and Susana Patricia.

Dr. Garcia began his medical practice in Corpus Christi in 1946, and became involved in addressing the concerns of our nation's residents of Mexican descent. Focusing on veterans' issues, Dr. Garcia founded the American G.I. Forum in 1948, which soon became one of the country's outstanding Hispanic organizations. Over the years, he has held many official positions and has received numerous awards for his service to humanity. In 1984, Dr. Garcia was awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom, the highest honor given to a civilian by the President of the United States.

Dr. Garcia donated his extensive papers to Corpus Christi State University as a research and educational resource for the people of Texas. Housed in the Special Collections & Archives Department of the CCSU Library, the Dr. Hector P. Garcia Papers consist of over 350 cubic feet of documents assembled by Dr. Garcia during his lifetime of activity. These materials reflect Mexican American history during the last half of the twentieth century and ensure that CCSU will be a center of research on our nation's expanding Hispanic population.
