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Cardinal

No bird signifies the holidays more than the bright crimson cardinal, a common sight throughout most of the eastern and southern U. S. Cardinals are nonmigratory, and thrive in small family flocks. The female is tawny brown, and both sexes have a distinctive head crest. These year-round residents readily visit feeders — especially those stocked with sunflower seeds. The cardinal's stout, conical bill is perfectly suited for cracking seeds.
