Dear Mr. Salinas:

I am writing regarding your recent inquiry about the steps that are required for naming a post office.

I have contacted Mr. John Hagarty, of the United States Postal Service, and he has informed me that, to have this done, it must be introduced in a bill. The U. S. Postal Service takes no position on the naming of post office facilities.

Mr. Hagarty also informed me that the naming might meet with less complication if the facility in question is presently unnamed. Another point of interest might be to note that it is highly unusual for postal facilities to be named after someone who is still living. In the past, it has been under extreme circumstances that this has been permitted.

Thank you for informing me of your interest in this matter. I will be talking to some of my fellow colleagues and looking into the possibilities of introducing this bill.
