The Conference was called in lieu of a meeting. The purpose of the call was to discuss the following points:

1) The Executive Committee to meet sometime in February in Washington, D.C.

Motion made by Pablo Sedillo to meet on the 13th. Seconded by Chris Baca. Approved unanimously.

Location to be determined within the next two weeks

2) Motion was made by Chris Baca that a reception be hosted by NAFADA on Capitol Hill on Thursday, February 11th (tentative date) to honor Congressmen, Senators and Public Officials who support the war against substance abuse. Cost \$2,500. Pablo Sedillo seconded and it passed unanimously.

The Chairman assured the Committee that he will be responsible for obtaining funds. Mr. Baca offered assistance and support, should it be necessary.

Pablo Sedillo made a motion that the National Hispanic Family Against Drug Abuse host an institute on September 9, 10 and 11, 1988, to address the issue of substance abuse and related issues that resolve from alcoholism and drugs with youth, children and families, as well as the implications of drug abuse to the Hispanic families (i.e., transmission of the AIDS virus to children, youth and families). The Institute will also address family violence as a result of substance abuse and the development of support systems to combat alcoholism, drugs and the deceased and dying.

At the proposed February 13 meeting an Agenda will be developed for the institute to discuss services, training and research in the areas of substance abuse.
