Further reference is made to your interest in the case of Mr. Felix R. Saucedo, a former employee of the Naval Hospital, Corpus Christi, Texas.

The record established in Mr. Saucedo's case shows that he was employed by the Corpus Christi, Texas Naval Hospital on September 25, 1967, through a career-conditional appointment. This employment was made subject to the satisfactory completion of a one-year probationary period. The agency was not satisfied with Mr. Saucedo's work performance during the probationary period and he was accordingly informed by a July 15, 1968 written notice that his appointment would be terminated on July 29, 1968. After receiving this notice, Mr. Saucedo submitted a resignation to the Naval Hospital on July 15, 1968, and in keeping with its terms, he was separated from the agency's rolls on July 19, 1968.

Under the circumstances surrounding Mr. Saucedo's case, I have no authority to take any action concerning the termination of his employment.

I regret that I must make this report concerning the case. I am attaching a copy of a letter this Region addressed to Mr. Saucedo informing him of our findings.
