Dear Mr. Young:

This is in reply to your most recent inquiry concerning Petty Officer Roberto J. Delgado, Boiler Technician second class, United States Navy.

Upon receipt of your previous inquiry of February 14, 1977, a careful review was made of Petty Officer Delgado's situation. Based on Petty Officer Delgado's paygrade and time-in-service, he is considered a careerist. As such, he is assigned to duty in accordance with the sea and shore rotational requirements of his rate and rating. Petty Officer Delgado's shore tour ends in August and his tour of duty in Corpus Christi, Texas cannot be extended. To authorize Petty Officer Delgado such special assignment would be unfair to his contemporaries with similar desires to whom this same consideration is not extended. Petty Officer Delgado is scheduled for transfer to sea duty aboard the USS NORTON SOUND (AVM-1), and it is expected that his reassignment will take place in August as planned.

Thank you for writing. I regret that a more favorable reply could not be provided.
