Dear Doctor Garcia:

This refers to your letter dated 16 May 1968 concerning Mrs. Margaret Crews.

A review of our records reveals that Mrs. Crews submitted an application to this Center for Fabric Worker positions which is being retained in our active files. Our past employment pattern reveals that vacancies for Fabric Worker positions at the grade level for which Mrs. Crews is qualified do not occur frequently and, in addition, competition among present employees for this type position is quite keen.

In view of the recent authority granted us to increase our personnel workforce, we are endeavoring to recognize by promotion those employees who have been performing satisfactorily as temporary and/or term appointees. This action will result in employing a large number of applicants at the Helper W-05 level at \$2.76 an hour. Our employment procedures require that all applicants for Helper positions be referred to us by the local Civil Service Commission Interagency Board of Examiners for employment consideration. While Mrs. Crews has not been successful to date in establishing eligibility on the Helper examination, I strongly suggest that she endeavor to do so as soon as the examination is re-opened.
