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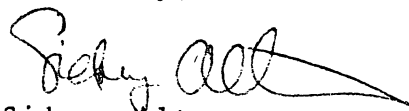
Dear Colleagues:

It is with great pleasure that I announce the appointment of Mary Romero as Assistant Dean at Yale College. Dr. Romero will serve as Coordinator of Chicano Student Affairs in Yale College--providing academic, personal, career, and other advice and counseling to Chicano Students; directing the activities of the Asian-Chicano Cultural Center and related academic and research activities; and serving as faculty adviser to M.E.Ch.A., the Chicano student organization at Yale. She will also be engaged in minority student admissions, freshman orientation, community relations, and readmissions to Yale College.

Dr. Romero received her doctorate in sociology from the University of Colorado. In addition to teaching in the Sociology Department at the University of Texas at El Paso, she has served as an Assistant Professor in the Division of Behavioral Science at the University of Wisconsin-Parkside and as Visiting Assistant Professor in Chicano Studies at the University of Colorado at Boulder. She has been active in the National Association of Chicano Studies and currently serves as the midwest representative to the Coordinating Committee. Dr. Romero plans to continue research on the Chicana work experience, particularly in the area of domestic service.

Dr. Romero replaces Maria Martha Chavez-Brumell, who resigned to work at the University of Chicago under a national Hispanic Leadership Fellowship award. All correspondence concerning Chicano activities at Yale College should henceforth be directed to Dr. Romero.
