One thousand thanks for your kindness and your assistance that you gave Adriana Cecilia and myself during our visit to Omaha and Lincoln.

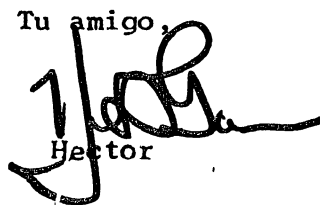
