The Military Affairs Committee of the Chamber will meet at 4 p.m., Tuesday, February 11 in the Board Room at the Chamber.

The purpose of the meeting is to review suggested projects and make a decision as to which two or three to undertake during 1986.

During 1985 the Steering Committee of the Military Affairs Committee met with the commanding officers of the Army, Navy, Marine and Coast Guard; with an Advisory Committee composed of mostly enlisted personnel recommended by the C.O's; and with representatives from each of the military-related organizations. The purpose of these meetings was to formulate ideas and a plan of action to assist the military in becoming more integrated with the citizens of Corpus Christi.

ACCOMPLISHMENTS DURING 1985

In September, the Committee initiated recognition of six military at the monthly Chamber breakfast. [NOTE: to be continued in 1986 on a bimonthly basis starting with the March 18 breakfast.]

In November, the Committee arranged a reception on board the tall ship Elissa. One hundred military, including their spouses, were hosted at the reception by local businesses.
