THE AMERICAN GI FORUM OF THE STATE OF TEXAS AND THE AMERICAN GI FORUM OF THE UNITED STATES, A NATIONAL ORGANIZATION OF AMERICAN VETERANS OF MEXICAN ORIGIN WISH TO CONGRATULATE THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR FOR THE STAND THEY HAVE TAKEN IN THE COMMUTERS PROBLEMS ALONG THE BORDER.

IT IS CERTAINLY HIGH TIME THAT OUR AMERICAN PEOPLE OF MEXICAN ORIGIN AND AMERICAN LABORERS BE GIVEN PREFERENCE OVER FOREIGN WORKERS. YOU CAN TAKE IT FROM ME PERSONALLY THAT THE WHOLE BORDER FROM THE MOUTH OF THE RIO GRANDE TO CALIFORNIA, IS ONE OF THE GREATEST DEPRESSED AREAS IN THE WHOLE U.S.A. THIS IS ONE OF THE AREAS IN WHOCH OUR AMERICAN PEOPLE OF MEXICAN ORIGIN DO NOT MAKE A DESCENT LIVING. IT IS A SOURCE OF MIGRATORY MOVEMENT IN THE NATIONA BECAUSE OF THE DEPRESSED WAGES BROUGHT ON BY THE COMMUTERS.

I DEFINITELY BELIEVE THAT IF A PERSON WANTS TO APPLY FOR PERMANENT VISA, HE SHOULD LIVE IN THIS COUNTRY AND ALSO HAVE THE OBLIGATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITY OF BEING A RESIDENT AS WELL AS ITS PRIVILEGE. THE AMERICAN GI FORUM HAS GONE ON RECORD IN RECOMMENDING MILITARY SERVICE AND DRAFT REGISTRATION FOR THE MALE.

THE AMERICAN PEOPLE OF MEXICAN ORIGIN IN THE UNITED STATES HAVE BEEN LONG ENOUGH EXPLOITED BY EVERYONE. | BELIEVE THAT THIS WILL BE A RIGHT STEP IN THE RIGHT DIRECTION IN HOLDING YOUR POSITION AND IN GIVING THIS GREAT GROUP OF LOYAL AMER-ICANS OF MEXICAN ORIGIN A DESCENT STANDARD OF LIVING.

WE HAVE ENOUGH WORKERS IN THESE BORDER AREAS WHO WANT TO MAKE A DESCENT ENOUGH LIVING TO PAY TAXES, TO EDUCATE THEIR CHILDREN, TO FEED THEIR CHILDREN AND HAVE A DESCENT STANDARD OF LIVING. THEREFORE, I AM BEGGING YOU, AGAIN, TO KEEP WORK-ING ON THE PROBLEM AND RECEIVE FROM THE AMERICAN GI FORUM OF THE NATION WITH GROUPS IN TWENTY-FOUR STATES AND THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, OUR COMPLETE SUPPORT.
