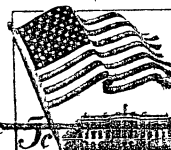
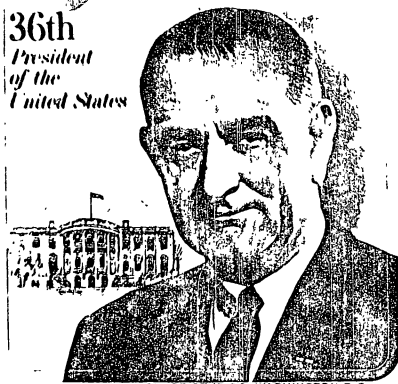

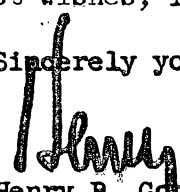
Today, January 20, 1965, is another great milestone in our history -- the Inauguration of our 36th President, Lyndon Baines Johnson.
