Dear Dr. Garcia:

We have enclosed three items which may be of interest:

- 1. A statement on the new regulations issued by the Secretary of Labor regarding the admission of foreign farm workers. Representatives of both organized labor and of the Mexican American community had urged that growers be required to offer domestic workers higher wages in order to qualify for foreign workers. This week the Secretary increased the so-called "adverse effect rate" from \$1.40 an hour to \$1.60 an hour.
- 2. An analysis of the implications to the Mexican American community of the President's Civil Rights message.
- 3. The White House press release announcing your appointment and that of others to the National Advisory Council on Economic Opportunity.

We will continue to send you similar material as it becomes available.
