Thank you very kindly for your letter of June 8th. It is always a pleasure to hear from you and to be of service wherever possible.

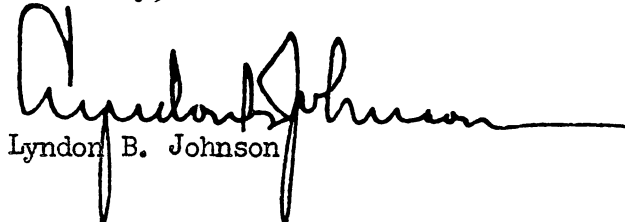
As yet the Court Martial transcript has not arrived, but I will be on the look out for it and give it careful attention.

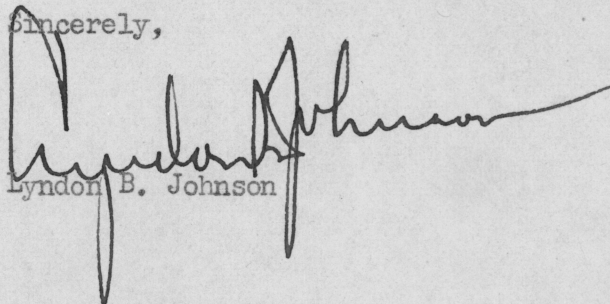
I have read over the Court Martial transcript that you sent me and noted the discrepancies you pointed out.
