This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of March 17, 1978, with enclosure, regarding the appeal of Mr. Ricardo Perez, 121 7th Avenue, Portland, Texas 78374.

On the basis of a request filed by Mr. Perez' attorney, the Appeals Review Board, by decision issued March 9, 1978, reopened the September 14, 1976 decision of the Dallas Field Office, Federal Employee Appeals Authority, which affirmed the action of the U.S. Postal Service, Corpus Christi, Texas, whereby Mr. Perez was suspended for 60 days.

After comments from the agency on the representations submitted in support of the request for reopening, the Board will issue its reconsideration decision.

The Board is attempting to adjudicate requests and appeals as expeditiously as possible, considering the complexity of the issues involved. When a decision is issued, the Board will promptly notify all parties.
