Thank you for your letter of May 11th regarding the above lady. Mrs. Sanchez brought the letter to me yesterday.

Bee County does not have a surplus commodity so it will be impossible to help her in this way.

I talked to Mrs. Sanchez at great length and also with the local office of the State Welfare. It seems that under our present law Mrs. Sanchez is receiving the maximum amount allowed by the State Welfare Department, being \$107.00 per month. Mrs. Young who is with the State Welfare Department told me that she was also writing you so maybe she has explained this to you much better than I have.

I will talk to the Principal of the school and see if the children can be placed on the school lunch program.

If I can be of further help in this matter please call upon me.
