This is in response to your referral of the letter of Mr. Isaac P. Borjas, East Chicago, Indiana, regarding a complaint of employment discrimination against the Pabst Brewery, Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

My subcommittee is presently holding hearings on H.R. 1746, which would establish enforcement procedures for the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission. Though the Commission presently has only conciliatory functions, they have been successful in resolving some complaints. It would seem to me Mr. Borjas should at least submit his grievance to the Commission, if he has not already done so.

With regard to the embargo on shipments of the company's products to overseas bases, I think this matter should be brought to the attention of the Secretary of Defense.
