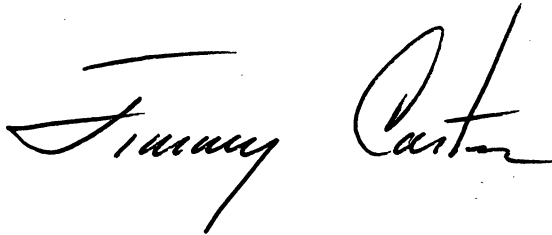
To Dr. Hector Garcia
