Your letter of September 13, in which you called my attention to the concerns of Mr. and Mrs. Del Rio, has been received. I asked Mr. Don Parish, director of special education, to confer with the principal of Calk Elementary School, Mr. Rolor Ray, and he has reported the following to me:

Mr. Rolor Ray had a conference with Mr. and Mrs. Del Rio on September 8. The Del Rios had indicated that their daughter, Brenda, was somewhat fearful of her resource teacher. After the conference between Mr. Ray, the resource teacher, and the Del Rios, the difficulty appeared to be resolved.

Mr. Ray called Mrs. Del Rio last Friday afternoon to be sure that everything was still progressing in a positive manner. Mrs. Del Rio responded that she felt everything was in good order, and that should things not work out or become difficult for Brenda, she would contact Mr. Ray.

It appears, Dr. Garcia, that the problem has been resolved. However, if it develops that this is not the case, I would appreciate your letting me know.
