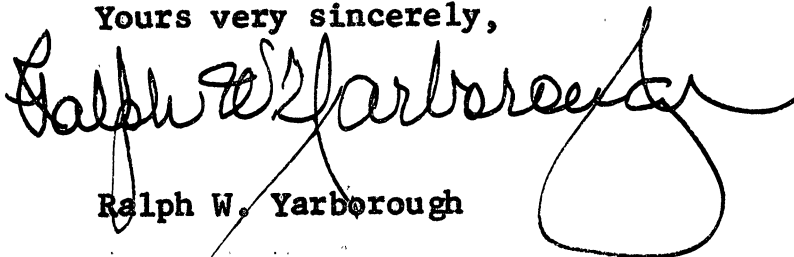
This will acknowledge your letter of March 4 with enclosures in the interest of Private Oscar Rosales.
