- Married to Elva Ann Hughes 32 years—4 children—5 grandchildren—reared in Hico, Hamilton County—U.S. Navy 2 years—Age. 60.
- Practiced law in San Angelo, Tom Green County, 20 years—City Attorney and 51st Judicial District Attorney, San Angelo, Elected Associate Justice Austin Court of Civil Appeals 1946—re-elected twice without **opposition**.
- Judge Hughes' opponent is now on the Supreme Court and will remain on it until 1963, regardless of the outcome of this election. *He now has all the Judicial authority and salary* he could have if elected chief justice. His election would create a vacancy on the Supreme Court which would be filled by **appointment, not by election**.
- Judge Hughes has had about four years more judicial experience and has written about 200 more Court opinions than his opponent.
- Judge Hughes seeks **promotion** in order to serve the entire State.
- Judge Hughes does not merely seek a title.
