Your fine letter of April 27 has just reached my desk. I appreciate very much your kind expressions.

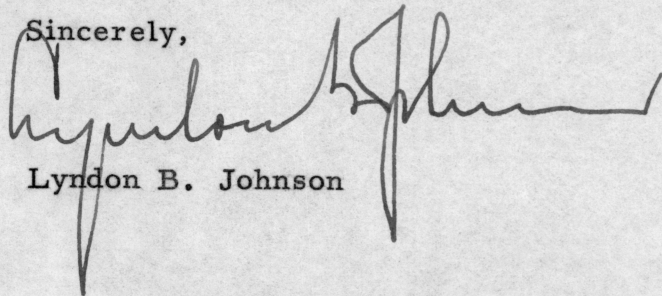

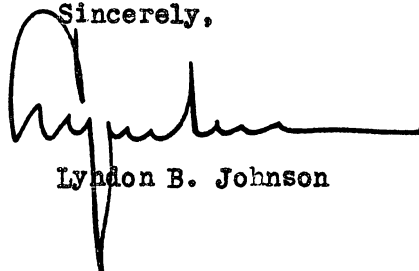
Dear Hector:
