Senate Bill 195 was not adopted by the Sixty-sixth Texas Legislature. It was felt by many legislators that more study is needed on the issue before an extension of mandatory bilingual education is made.

I plan to investigate the matter during the interim and work closely with the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare to determine national trends, special needs in Texas, and educational improvements resulting from bilingualism. This effort should help in the future development of a proper state policy.
