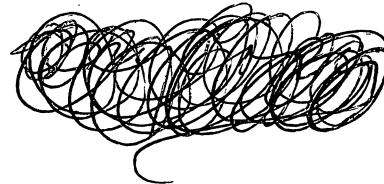

I would like to thank you for your letter of June 5th which cites the statistics, up to January 31, 1967, concerning the participation of Mexican-American girls in the Job Corps Centers.

I am sorry to say this information is not helpful, because of the highly, wide press coverage given when a bus load of Mexican-Americans girls left the center in Albuquerque for their homes in the Valley in Texas.

Because of this incident I hesitate in quoting said figures either to the Ladies Auxiliary or to the communities.

Nevertheless, I am most grateful for your help, and do look forward to a more recent survey.
